# International Cancer Screening Network Meeting

**June 2–4, 2015 • Rotterdam, The Netherlands**

The **2015 International Cancer Screening Network (ICSN) Triennial Meeting** will take place on **June 2-4 in Rotterdam, The Netherlands**. The ICSN meeting will focus on collaborative research that is aimed at identifying and fostering efficient and effective approaches to cancer control worldwide through population-based screening. The 2015 meeting is cosponsored by the National Cancer Institute and the Erasmus Medical Center.

  - Individualized screening
  - Implementation and lessons learned from organized programs in middle to high resource countries

  - Informed decision making in cancer screening

  - Be first author on an abstract submitted to the ICSN 2015 meeting
