

Public Health Etiquette and Positive Test/Symptoms Reporting Contact Information

COVID Etiquette and Information – While the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency has officially ended, there are some illness prevention recommendations that you can still follow. Masks are suggested but are optional. If you forget to bring a mask, they will be available at the registration desk. Please be considerate of those seated nearby you. If they are wearing a mask, you may want to consider wearing one as well or allowing separation between you and that person, depending on what is possible given the room set-up.

Hand sanitizer stations are available at locations around the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Center (FHCC). Hand sanitizer will also be available at the registration desk and will be available for those who want to take a dispenser for use in their conference room.

At FHCC, conference rooms generally will have an air exchange rate of 8 each hour. Generally, commercial property should have at least a rate of four air changes per hour, while classrooms should generally have at least a rate of 6.

Reporting a Positive COVID Test or Symptoms – If you have a positive COVID test and/or symptoms, do not attend any additional meetings. Please attend virtually for the remainder of the meetings. Please report your symptoms to biostat@fredhutch.org or call Denise Albano at 206-667-6415 (please leave a message if there is no answer). Your confidentiality will be respected (unless you specifically indicate otherwise), but you should indicate which meetings you have attended, and where you have eaten lunch each day. We will distribute information that someone who attended those meetings or lunches has reported COVID symptoms and/or a positive test.
